*Read Exodus 3:8*

Ask God to rescue communities with little water access from drought and starvation.

2

*Read Isaiah 40:29* Pray for rural villages that are working hard to drill wells, install hand pumps, and train their residents to maintain the pumps.

3

*Read Psalm 23:2*

The common saying, “water is life,” describes reality for small rural villages in Sub-Saharan Africa. Pray locals will survive the catastrophic effects of ongoing drought.

4

*Read Hosea 6:3*

Pray for projects in Central Asia that are providing communities with the first clean water wells they’ve ever enjoyed.

5

*Read Isaiah 40:31*

Ask God to heal the millions around the world who suffer from debilitating waterborne illnesses.

6

*Read Psalm 8:2*

BGR partners are distributing water filters to schools in a Southeast Asian region. Pray they can effectively help children who have no access to clean water.

7

*Read Jeremiah 17:8*

Ask God to grant BGR teams endurance, wisdom, faith, and compassion as they enter villages and provide water filters.

8

*Read Proverbs 2:6*

Ask God to give BGR community health teachers wisdom as they teach Southeast Asian villagers about water sanitation, waterborne illnesses, and good hygiene.

9

*Read Psalm 31:24*

Clean water is becoming harder and harder for people to access in many rural parts of the world. Pray for BGR partners who are using a water filtration process as the centerpiece of water programs.

10

*Read Psalm 120:1*

Pray teams that are testing water sources in a region of South Asia can help communities find clean water supplies.

*Read 2 Corinthians 9:8*

Pray for churches that are working with their local communities to find better sources of clean water.

12

*Read Matthew 10:42*

Pray for volunteer teams that travel to many parts of the world to install wells for communities in need.

13

*Read Psalm 5:11*

Pray for the safety of well-digging crews as they use picks and sledgehammers to construct hand-dug wells in an area where underground rocks prohibit the use of drilling machines.

14

*Read Psalm 23:4*

Pray for those who must walk long distances to obtain drinking water during the dry seasons of the year.

15

*Read John 7:38*

Pray Christ's love will touch villagers' hearts as BGR partners install water wells in their communities.

16

*Read John 4:10*

Pray for communities in West Africa that only have a few closed wells with hand pumps, forcing women to rise early in the morning and get in line to draw water.

17

*Read Isaiah 35:7*

Pray for villages where natural springs of water have dried up and residents greatly need deep wells.

18

*Read Jeremiah 33:6*

Pray for communities where the lack of clean water has caused a domino effect in the health of families and children.

19

*Read Isaiah 35:6*

In some areas, water has become very expensive. Pray for the poor and needy, especially the elderly, who have no means to purchase clean water.

20

*Read Deuteronomy 8:7*

Pray for rural villages that have outgrown their infrastructure for clean water access and now must find new water sources.

*Read Philippians 4:7*

Pray for communities where natural disasters, such as floods and landslides, have wreaked havoc on existing water systems.

22

*Read Jeremiah 30:17*

Pray for regions of the world where the water contains organic material and microbes from fecal and garbage pollution. This contamination negatively affects people's health.

23

*Read Psalm 145:17-18*

Pray BGR water projects will be completed on time, without disruptions and interruptions in the work.

24

*Read Psalm 84:11*

Ask God to give BGR partners and local churches wisdom as they work alongside rural villages to analyze water problems and develop solutions.

25

*Read John 4:14* Pray those who receive wells and water filters will also find the Living Water to satisfy their souls and spirits.

26

*Read Isaiah 32:2*

Pray communities will unite as they tackle problems associated with inadequate water supplies.

27

*Read Psalm 65:9*

Pray for communities that are vulnerable to malnutrition and dehydration because of poor water quality.

28

*Read Isaiah 44:3*

Pray BGR partners can successfully construct spring-fed water systems for Central Asian villages that currently rely on dirty canals and rivers for primary drinking water sources.

29

*Read Psalm 90:17*

Pray church leaders will find favor with government officials as they apply for permits to install water wells in needy communities.

30

*Read Psalm 72:6*

Pray for extremely remote villages that are located several kilometers away from water sources, making clean, safe water is a top priority.
